Kiwi Singer Songwriter Ralph Bennett-Eades is touring the North Island Singing his N.Z. RoadSongs and Blues. Finger Picking, Sliding and Strumming it up on a bunch of unique Guitars.

What are Road Songs? Songs that are written while traveling, or, the recollection of the journeys themselves, in Ralph's case they are for the most part about the South Island and his years of touring in his House Bus with the Gypsy Fair. "Heaps of Creeks", "Talkin' bout the West Coast", "Hi Way 99" from his "Southern Journey" C.D.

For the last 6 years Ralph and his family have made Motueka their base which oddly enough has meant even more traveling, "Karamea to Kathmandu" in fact, and it's also the name of a C.D. of his resonator instrumentals. A few yarns seem to weave themselves into his show these days and there are North Island Road Songs too "10 Foot Road" and "Sho Nuff" about his travels with Shayn Wills and the Blue Buffoons.

Ralph recorded a live concert in Devonport Folk Club's "Bunker" with Shayn and four others on board. Shayn will be accompanying Ralph on Harmonica and Guitar and also performing his own Kiwi Road Songs at "Valhalla Cafe" as guests of the Kapiti Live Acoustic Music Club on Wednesday 18th of Aug. The pair will round off the show with a bunch of Blues to get that Hollerin', Stompin', and old time shimmyin' goin' on.
